1. When will the admission window open?

Note: BCD does not offer a MTech. (Research) degree.

3. What is the selection procedure, is there any entrance test?

• There is NO entrance test, the candidates are shortlisted for interview based on the qualifying degree. The final selection is based on the performance in the interview.
