Note: BCD does not offer a MTech. (Research) degree.

- 3. What is the selection procedure?
 - Candidates are shortlisted for the interview based on their qualifying degree. Final selection is determined by their performance in the interview.
- 4. Is it same (affiliated) or how it is different from Centre for Brain Research?
 - This is a Ph.D. degree program offered by IISc. There is no affiliation to CBR.
- 5. Will you be considering GATE scores for admission purposes?
